## (i) the particulars of its organisation, functions and duties

Asannagar Madan Mohan Tarkalankar College, a government-aided institution affiliated to the University of Kalyani, Nadia, West Bengal, approved by the UGC under section 2(f) and 12 B and accredited by NAAC (1<sup>st</sup> Cycle, Grade B) was established in 2007 and is located in 56 Majhdia Road, P.O. Asannagar, Nadia, West Bengal, Pin- 741161.The college has the following departments: Bengali, English, Sanskrit, History, Philosophy, Physical Education, Political Science, Education, Environmental Studies, Geography, Defence Studies. The college at present runs the following undergraduate courses (Major): Bengali, History, English, Sanskrit, Education, Philosophy, Political Science, Physical Education. The college has its NSS units to conduct outreach activities and a newly introduced NCC unit. The college seeks to offer academic opportunities to pupils coming from rural communities many of whom are socially underprivileged. The college is also committed to ensure a decentralized mode of operation and to introduce quality-related measures in the overall functioning through IQAC. The governance of the college is managed as per the rules and the guidelines of the UGC, Higher Education Department, Government of West Bengal and the affiliating university.

- (ii) the powers and duties of its officers and employees
- (a) Principal: Principal plays a key role in college governance system in monitoring the process of ongoing academic and research activities, adopting effective administrative measures, and placing the recommendations coming from the subcommittees in the Governing Body meetings as the Secretary of the Governing Body for framing policies
- (b) Bursar: Bursar is responsible for framing financial policies, setting policies for budget allocation and the utilisation of fund, verifying and authenticating the bills, streamlining the activities of the accounts section, keeping the cash book and office ledger in an appropriate shape, locating opportunities for fund generation.
- (c) Coordinator, IQAC: Monitoring the institutional functioning towards quality enhancement, coordinating various activities aimed at ensuring quality culture, establishing a mechanism for documenting quality-related activities
- (d) Librarian: Lending books to the students and teachers following internal guidelines, taking care of the books, journals and reference materials kept in the library, displaying the newspapers and magazines, maintaining a record of the purchase of books and journals, offering assistance to students interested in using INFLIBNET.
- (e) Teachers: Conducting teaching-learning activities, setting questions for written examination forming a segment of internal assessment, setting questions for term-end university examination, if and whenever asked, performing invigilation duties, checking answer scripts of the internal examination and the answer scripts of term-end university examination, if and whenever required.

(f) Non-teaching Staff: Conducting daily office activities related to academics and administration as instructed by the authority

All the powers and duties of the employees are finally determined by the directives coming from the UGC, the Government and the affiliating university.

(iii)the procedure followed in the decision-making process, including channels of supervision and accountability

As far as the decision-making process is concerned, the administrative segment possessing highest form of control in a government aided college like ours is the governing body which includes the Principal of the college as Secretary, the President of the governing body nominated by the government, two government nominees, one state council nominee, two nominees from the affiliating university, three teacher representatives and one non-teaching representative. The decision-making process, however is decentralized. The various internally formed subcommittees routine subcommittee, library subcommittee, admission and cells (academic subcommittee, subcommittee and examination subcommittee related to different phases of teaching-learning, games and sports subcommittee[accommodating a student representative], cell against sexual harassment, anti-ragging subcommittee[accommodating a student representative], internal students' committee[accommodating a student representative], complaints cell[accommodating a student representative], canteen subcommittee[accommodating a student representative], magazine subcommittee[accommodating a student representative], cultural placement representative], student subcommittee[accommodating а cell[accommodating a student representative]related to the welfare of students, building subcommittee for taking care of the existing infrastructure and mapping its further extension, the service cell, leave subcommittee, GPF subcommittee related to the welfare of the employees, website maintenance subcommittee and RTI cell for disseminating information, purchase subcommittee and e-tender subcommittee in connection with the purchase of necessary items), The Teachers Council and IQAC(accommodating a student representative), hold meetings at regular intervals to offer necessary recommendations which are placed in the governing body meetings for further scrutiny and approval. There is also a provision for the functioning of an autonomous students' union. The economic affairs and management of the institution are planned by the statutory finance subcommittee and monitored by the Bursar, while the final approval, as usual, comes from the governing body. The IQAC sets guideline for and monitors all the activities aimed at bringing in quality measures in the institution. The non-teaching staff council and the staff council are also supposed to play roles in the participatory mode of managing the affairs in the institution.

Internal norms are set by the Governing Body in consideration of recommendations coming from IQAC, Teachers' Council, Non-teaching Staff Council and the various subcommittees.
